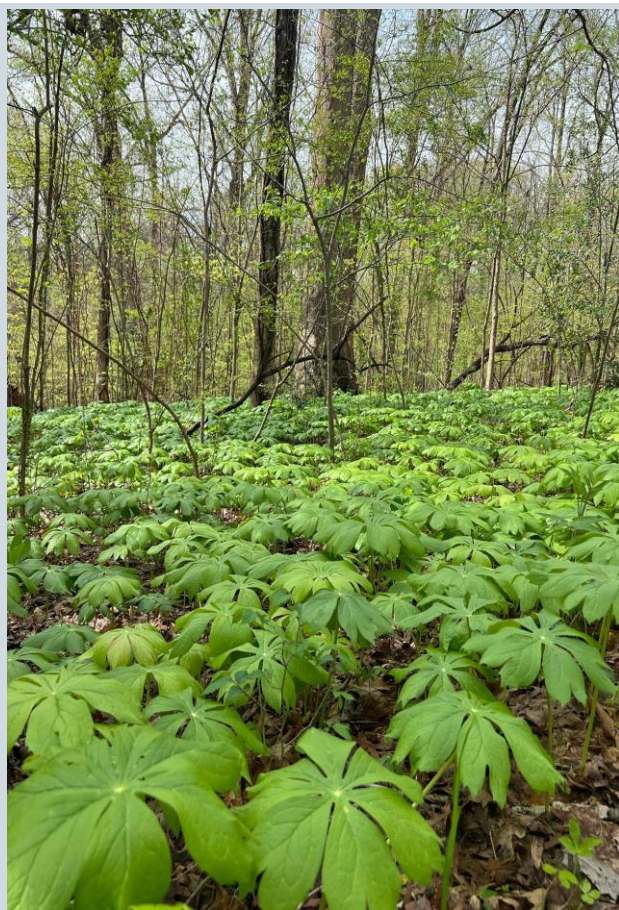

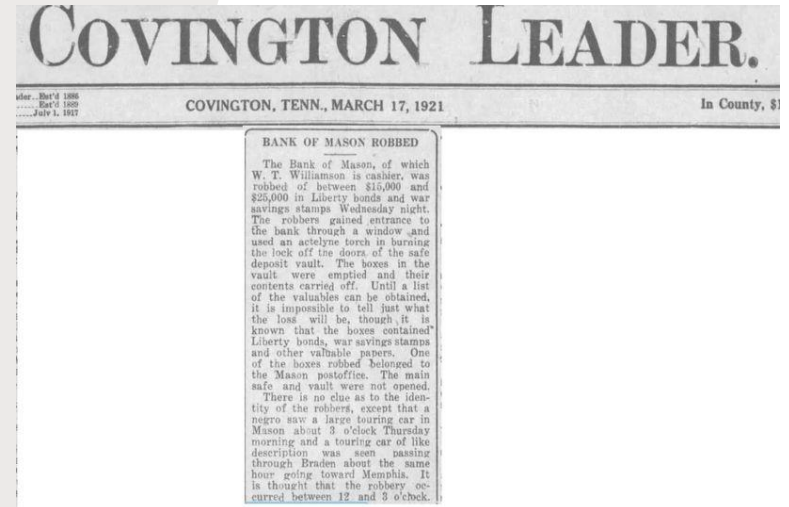
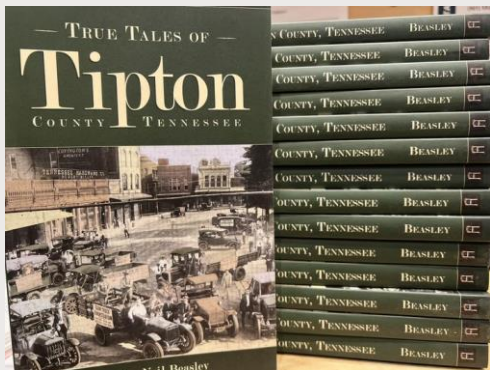

**BANK OF MASON ROBBED**  
The Bank of Mason, of which W. T. Williamson is cashier, was robbed of between \$15,000 and \$20,000 in Liberty bonds and war savings stamps Wednesday night. The robbers gained entrance to the bank through a window and used an acetylene torch in burning the lock off the doors of the safe deposit vault. The boxes in the vault were emptied and their contents carried off. Until a list of the valuables can be obtained, it is impossible to tell just what the loss will be, though it is known that the boxes contained Liberty bonds, war savings stamps and other valuable papers. One of the boxes robbed belonged to the Mason postoffice. The main safe and vault were not opened. There is no clue as to the identity of the robbers, except that a negro saw a large touring car in Mason about 3 o'clock Thursday morning and a touring car of like description was seen passing through Erden about the same hour going toward Memphis. It is thought that the robbery occurred between 12 and 3 o'clock.

Softball/Baseball/Soccer Update:

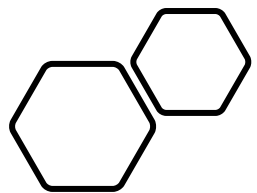
Softball games will be played on Monday night and Friday night at the baseball fields.

Baseball games were not interrupted - they will play on Tuesday and Thursday night

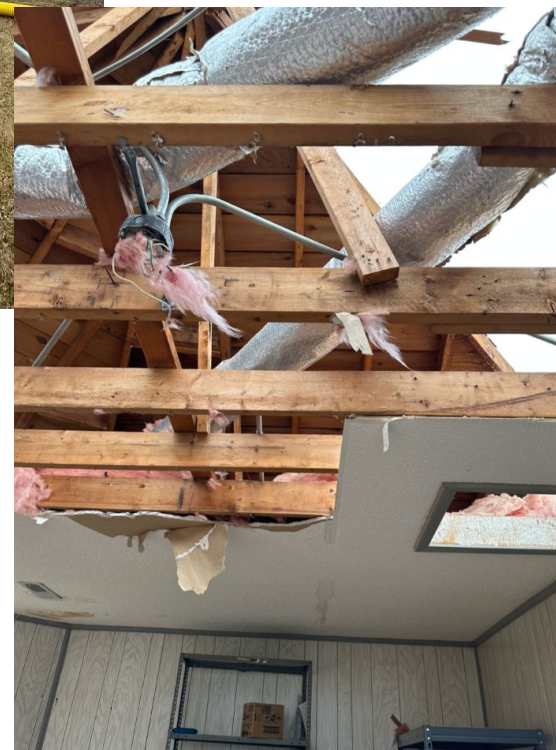
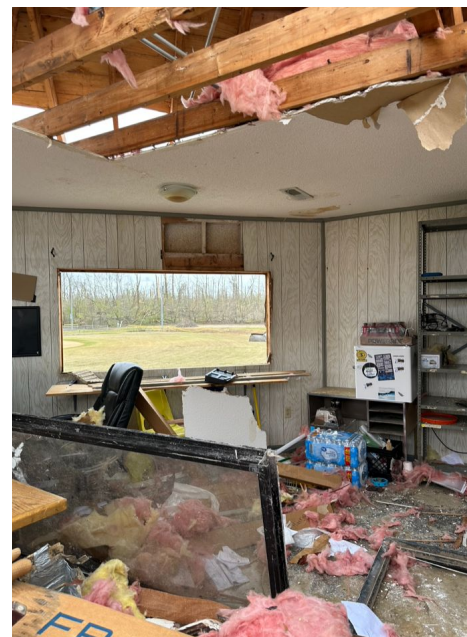
Soccer games will now be played on Tipton County Schools property between CIAA and TLC/ALC.

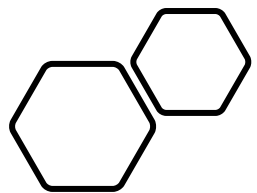
