Charger Alumni Music Festival - Originally Scheduled for April 1, moved to July 1 because of a tornado.

Time: Setup 10am, event Noon - 6pm, cleanup @6pm.

Mr. Hall reached out and has decided to move his date to July 1. There have been some changes since the tornado, but he has been made aware of the changes and is good to go.

- The event will take place inside of the riding arena area (not the dirt portion - the grass/gravel portion) so that he is still able to make this a ticketed event and not close the entire park.
- There will only be one entrance for people to enter through (the white fence/red gate closest to the Boy Scout Hut and the Horse Barn).
- He will have the stage and his vendors parked throughout the grass inside that area.
- He is providing a list of vendors to us for inspections.
- He has provided the ABC license of the vendor he is using for alcohol sales.
- Police department will staff the original discussed number of officers present (2 officers)
- Fire department will not staff the original discussed number of officers present (2 fire) citing for Mr. Hall to call 911 should there be a medical emergency.
- Parks and Recreation will staff the original discussed number of staff present (2 staff) to work the gate to monitor for the 15%.
- Molly will adjust Mr. Hall's invoice to reflect the changes in staffing.
