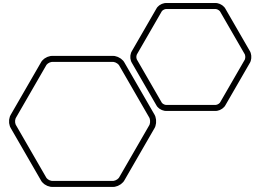
Mueller Update

- Will provide park structures, sidewalks, shade areas, accessible surfacing, benches, and a pavilion.



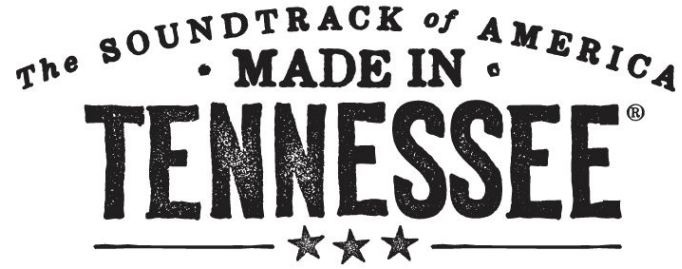
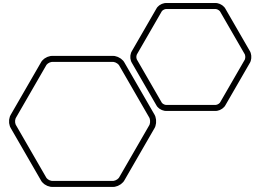

Covington High School Homecoming Parade

Hosted by: Covington High School

Event Date: Thursday, September 28, 2023

Location: College, Holmes, Main, Pep Rally at Court Square (west side)

Time: Lineup -5:00 pm, Parade Start at CHS - 5:30pm

Description: A school and community Homecoming Parade and Pep Rally to celebrate the 2023 Homecoming week. The event will begin at Covington High School (College Street). Judging of floats will take place on Fisher Avenue. The route of the parade will begin on College Street and proceed to Holmes Street to Main Street and stop on the west side of the court square for a Pep Rally (approx. 10-15 min.). After Pep rally floats will exit around and down the square returning to CHS via College Street. Floats will be parked on the track next to the scoreboard until after the football game Friday night.
