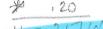

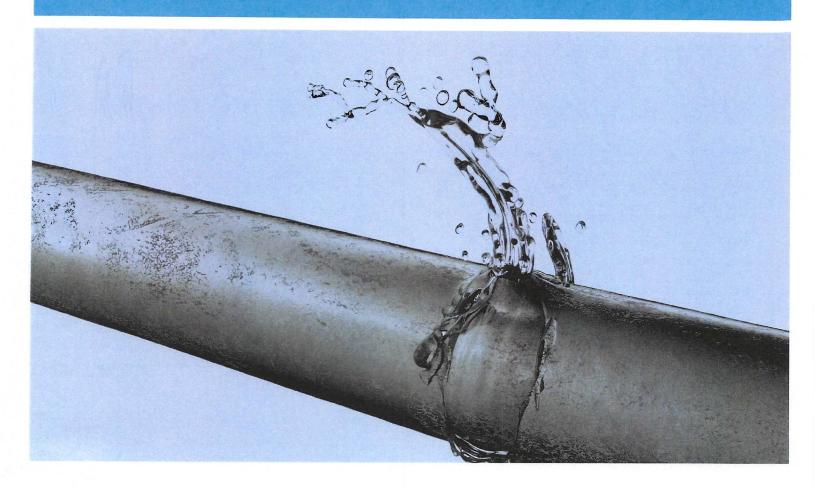

All eligible City of Covington customers are automatically enrolled in our optional expanded Water/Sewer Leak Loss Protection Program and charges will appear on your utility bill. 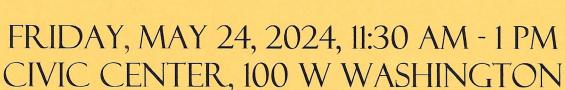
